

GUIDE TO RESPONSIBLE PARTICIPATION

Information for the Public

Autodromo Nazionale Monza adopts a sustainable management system for all events, aiming to reduce environmental impact, enhance local resources, protect the health and safety of people, ensure accessibility, and promote sustainable behavior. Sustainability is a shared responsibility. During events hosted at the Autodromo Nazionale Monza, every visitor is encouraged to adopt responsible behavior, respectful of both the environment and others. Small gestures, when shared, can generate lasting positive impact.

GOLDEN RULES FOR THE SUSTAINABLE SPECTATOR

DURING THE EVENT

1. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AND RULES

Respect all instructions provided by Autodromo staff and play your part in making events more sustainable.

2. SORT YOUR WASTE

Recycling bins are available throughout the Circuit. Use them properly for plastic, paper, glass, organic waste, and general waste. Do not litter — not even cigarette butts.

3. RESPECT OTHERS

Avoid occupying reserved areas, especially those designated for people with disabilities. Do not block access points, walkways, or emergency routes. Always behave respectfully towards other spectators. A sustainable event is also a safe and welcoming one.

4. BE SMART AND CONSUME RESPONSIBLY

Keep up responsible habits even while enjoying yourself. Use water moderately in the circuit's facilities. Turn off personal electronic devices when not in use. Every avoided waste benefits everyone.

5. TRAVEL RESPONSIBLY

Reach the Autodromo preferably by public transport, bicycle, scooter, or shared mobility services. If using a private vehicle, choose electric or hybrid cars and consider carpooling.

6. RESPECT THE PARK

Do not damage the trees or vegetation of the Autodromo Nazionale Monza, and do not disturb the park's wildlife.

7. LOUD NOISES

Protect children's and teenagers' hearing by using earplugs during high-volume events. Prolonged exposure can cause permanent hearing damage.

8. WATER BOTTLES

Bring a reusable water bottle (max 500 ml) and refill it at the designated water stations available inside the Autodromo.

IN DAILY LIFE

1. LIMIT ENERGY WASTE

Turn off electronic devices when not in use and unplug chargers. Take advantage of natural light as much as possible and use energy-saving lightbulbs where needed.

2. USE LED BULBS

Replace old lightbulbs with LED ones: they use less energy, last longer, and reduce environmental impact.

3. REDUCE WATER CONSUMPTION

Avoid letting water run unnecessarily during daily activities. Even small gestures, like turning off the tap while brushing your teeth, make a difference.

4. USE APPLIANCES EFFICIENTLY

Run them only with full loads and opt for low-temperature wash cycles. Efficient use reduces consumption and extends appliance life.

5. SET HEATING PROPERLY

Maintain indoor temperatures between 18–20°C. If it's too hot, adjust the thermostat instead of opening windows. Improve window insulation to reduce heat loss.

6. LOW-IMPACT TRANSPORTATION

When possible, leave your car at home—walk or cycle instead. Prefer public transport, bikes, or car sharing. If you drive, carpool and choose low-emission vehicles.
