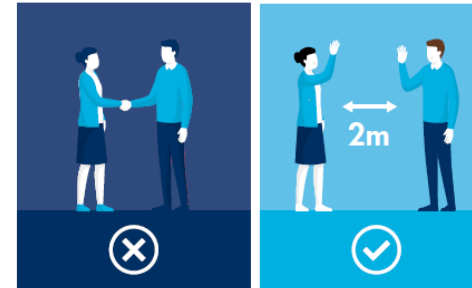

SOCIAL DISTANCING



To avoid catching the virus,
maintain a distance of at least two metres from one another.
This measure is highly recommended within your sub-group and
mandatory with everyone else.

General rules

GOOD HABITS TO ADOPT



Promote digital document sharing to avoid the transmission of paper documents



Wash or disinfect your hands **before and after handling any object that may be handled by someone else**



Disinfect your workspace before and after working



Share a car only with the members of your sub-group and wear a mask



Do not share lift with persons when not wearing a protective mask



Use individual water bottles or flasks



Do not share anything with your colleagues (equipment, bottles, cigarettes, etc.)



Touch stair handrails and door handles as little as possible



Use a disinfectant wipe and clean objects in communal areas **before touching them**



Wear protective equipment and follow airline/airport safety rules when you travel



In the hotel, stay in the FIA dedicated areas



Keep interactions to a minimum



Limit crossing paths with people in corridors; wait until they have gone past.

Protective measures

Protect others from getting sick

When coughing and sneezing **cover mouth and nose** with flexed elbow or tissue

 **Throw tissue into closed bin immediately after use**

Clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water after coughing or sneezing and when caring for the sick



HOW TO WEAR A NON-MEDICAL FABRIC MASK SAFELY who.int/epi-win


Do's →

- Adjust the mask to your face without leaving gaps on the sides
- Cover your mouth, nose, and chin
- Avoid touching the mask
- Clean your hands before touching the mask
- Inspect the mask for damage or if dirty
- Remove the mask by the straps behind the ears or head
- Wash the mask in soap or detergent, preferably with hot water, at least once a day
- Clean your hands after removing the mask
- Pull the mask away from your face
- Store the mask in a clean plastic, resealable bag if it is not dirty or wet and you plan to re-use it
- Remove the mask by the straps when taking it out of the bag

Don'ts →

- Do not wear the mask under the nose
- Do not remove the mask where there are people within 1 metre
- Do not use a mask that is difficult to breathe through
- Do not use a mask that looks damaged
- Do not wear a loose mask
- Do not share your mask with others
- Do not wear a dirty or wet mask

A fabric mask can protect others around you. To protect yourself and prevent the spread of COVID-19, remember to keep at least 1 metre distance from others, clean your hands frequently and thoroughly, and avoid touching your face and mask.



HOW TO WEAR A MEDICAL MASK SAFELY

Do's →

- Find the top side where the metal piece or stiff edge is
- Ensure the colored-side faces outwards
- Place the metal piece or stiff edge over your nose
- Cover your mouth, nose, and chin
- Adjust the mask to your face without leaving gaps on the sides
- Wash your hands before touching the mask
- Inspect the mask for tears or holes
- Avoid touching the mask
- Remove the mask from behind the ears or head
- Keep the mask away from you and surfaces while removing it
- Discard the mask immediately after use, preferably into a closed bin
- Wash your hands after discarding the mask

Remember that masks alone cannot protect you from COVID-19. Maintain at least 1 metre distance from others and wash your hands frequently and thoroughly, even while wearing a mask.

- Personal Protective Equipment (Boots, Hard hats, Hearing Protection, ...)
- Ladders and climbing procedures
- Regular scaffolds
- Regular Mobile Elevated Work Platform
- Regular Industrial trucks - Forklift
- Fall Protection
- Machinery, tools, equipment - properly use
- Safe behaviors
- Safe working procedures
