# TARGETS

SIAS S.p.A., in addition to its constant commitment to innovation and work organization, began in 2018 the new project "Monza4Safety" to strengthen the culture and awareness issues on health and safety for all employees of contractors and customers.

The first results of the work have been occurred in control and management of events involving all teams and customers.

In fact, security is for everyone and can not only be a competence of the Service Prevention and Protection.

It is important for management to ensure that all workers are involved and active in safety management.

In the Monza Circuit, are present many external subjects, public, customers, it is therefore essential that all the parties that perform activities in the area of the circuit are integrated into prevention and protection.





SIAS S.p.A., manager of the “National Circuit of Monza”, in relation to the scheduled events, informs all the promoters and organizers of events that:

the activities that take place at the Monza Circuit must comply with current legislation on safety and hygiene at work, including in particular:

- D.Lgs. 81/08 and s.m.i. (Title IV for "Temporary or Mobile Sites" and Article 26 of Legislative Decree 81/08 and subsequent amendments for the "Obligations connected to the contracting, work or supply contracts);
- Interministerial Decree 22 July 2014;
- Ministerial Decree 10.03.1998;
- Ministerial Decree 19.08.1996 (fire prevention for the design, construction and operation of entertainment and public entertainment venues).





Also remember that:

- The promoter and all the participating teams assume the position of "Customer" in relation to tasks entrusted to third parties, therefore having duties for assessment, management and coordination of the interferential risks (Article 26 of Legislative Decree 81/08 and subsequent amendments and / or Title IV);
- The promoter, and the teams, are responsible for managing safety and emergency during all phases of set-up and dismantling, within the areas assigned to them;
- All work activities must be carried out with the necessary prevention and protection measures expected by the above mentioned legislation and by the risk assessment of the promoter / team (Article 26 of Legislative Decree 81/08 and subsequent amendments and / or Title IV, and more..);
- S.I.A.S. S.p.A. will take an active part in supporting and promoting cooperation and coordination within its competence.



# WORKING PASS

## Working Pass System:

- At the Monza Circuit during all stages of preparation and mounting of events, an access control system is activated through the security service;
- Only personnel in possession of a working pass, delivery pass, or pass beforehand indicated by the promoter, will be able to access the set-up and dismantling areas;
- The Responsible of Safety & Security in agreement with the promoter, only at the end of the set-up phases involving interferential risks, will declare the paddok "open to the public";
- At the end of the event will be again declared "closed to the public" and the paddok will be accessible only to workers until complete dismantling;
- The Promoter must inform all the subjects involved of the system adopted.





The company S.I.A.S. S.p.A. makes available on its website (<https://www.monzanet.it/interno.php?id=14>):

- Informative documents (A01; A02; A09, A10; A13; and more....);
- Self-certification of compliance with safety and emergency regulations (A03) - obligatory for all;
- Copy of the documentation to be requested for the risks introduced (A06; A08) to teams, installers and suppliers who must have access during the preparation and dismantling phases.

If requested can be provided:

- Plan of the areas;
- General or preliminary emergency plan, remembering that it is up to the promoter and the individual teams to manage the emergency in the areas of their competence;
- Technical support for authorization activities.

If S.I.A.S. won't receive complete and signed documentation (if provided), at least 30 days before the event, will be interdicted access to the areas.



The Italian reference standard on safety at work (Legislative Decree 81/08 and subsequent amendments) is the standard that incorporates the following main EU directives:

- 89/391/CEE, 89/654/CEE, 89/655/CEE, 89/656/CEE, 90/269/CEE, 90/270/CEE, 90/394/CEE, 90/679/CEE, 93/88/CEE, 95/63/CE, 97/42/CE, 98/24/CE, 99/38/CE, 99/92/CE, 2001/45/CE, 2003/10/CE, 2003/18/CE e 2004/40/CE (improvement of the safety and health of workers at work);
- 92/57/CEE (improvement of the safety and health of workers at work);
- 80/1107/CEE, 82/605/CEE, 83/477/CEE, 86/188/CEE e 88/642/CEE, (exposure to chemical, physical and biological agents at work);
- 92/58/CEE (safety and/or health signal in the workplace);
- 2004/40/CE (exposure of workers to risks arising from physical agents such as electromagnetic fields);
- 2002/44/CE (risks deriving from mechanical vibrations);
- 2006/25/CE (exposure of workers to risks arising from physical agents such as optical radiation).
