4. ENTRIES

4.1 Opening date: 16 October 2025 Closing date: 16 November 2025

4.2 Registration procedure

Competitor registration must be done through the Rallyenter.it portal and the official ACI Sport portal.

The request will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee.

Foreign competitors and drivers must present:

- Authorization from their ASN
- Total amount of the participation fee.
- Valid license of the competitor, driver and co-driver.
- A passport photo for each crew member.
- First page of the technical passport of the cars with the number, group and cylindre capacity.

4.3 Admitted Competitors and Drivers

For each car, a crew of two people, both considered drivers and holding a valid license, must be entered. A driving license is not required given that the race takes place on a circuit. Foreign drivers must present the authorization issued by their NSA.

Given the nature of the competition – Rally Circuit - underage drivers are admitted provided they are 16 years old. The maximum number of competitors will be limited to 100. Beyond 100 entry requests, the organizer reserves the right to decide on the acceptance of competitors.

All cars must be equipped with FIA or ACI HTP or a Classic technical passport and comply with the technical and safety requirements of the Technical Regulations, Appendix K and the RNS.

CLASSIC CARS (Classified K)

Homologated cars equipped with FT3 or FT5 type safety tanks, accompanied by a Technical Passport, will compete among modern cars.

"SPECIAL GROUP MRS"

Allows the participation of cars of particular historical and/or competitive relevance, and not framed in the categories/classes indicated above. The organizer reserves the right to select the admitted cars at its discretion.

These cars will be admitted OUT OF CLASSIFICATION and will NOT compete for the overall results.

Cars must comply with minimum safety requirements.

For all cars: "Prova" plates are not allowed.

4.5.4 Refunds

Participation fees will be fully refunded:

- to competitors whose entry has not been accepted.
- In case of cancellation of the event.

5. Insurance

5.1 Introductory Notes

The entry fee includes insurance for the civil liability of competitors towards third parties for risks arising from circulation during the rally on the route described in the Road book.

5.2 Insurance Coverage

The organizer's insurance policy only covers damages caused to third parties or third-party property by the rally organizer or by drivers entered in the rally. Any other damages suffered by drivers or vehicles entered in the rally are not covered by insurance.

5.3 Responsibility of the organizers

The Rally organizer declines responsibility for any incident suffered by competitors or cars in the race during the entire duration of the event, even in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism, etc. Competitors and crew members will bear all consequences (material, criminal and sporting) deriving from any type of incident.

5.4 Duration of insurance coverage

The coverage will come into force at the start of the pre-race checks and will cease at the end of the event (Award Ceremony - Podium) or at the end of the post-race checks (for selected cars) and in case of withdrawal, disqualification or exclusion from the rally.

In case of withdrawal, the time taken into consideration will be the closing time of the subsequent TC.

Cars that re-enter the race after a possible withdrawal will not be considered as withdrawn.

The organization's Safety and Zero cars, and service cars used by Race Officials and Sports Delegates are covered by the event's insurance policy.

5.5 Insurance during recce

Cars used by crews during recce, even if they bear the specific event sticker, must be insured by their owners. The organizer has no responsibility for such cars and for drivers who only participate in the recce.

6. Advertising and identification

6.1 Advertising Restrictions

Tobacco advertising or tobacco products is prohibited in Italy. This law applies to cars, equipment and race clothing.





6.3 Identification

The race number and rally plate will be delivered by the organizer durig admin checks.

Numbers and plates must be affixed to the car before scrutineering and must be visible for the entire duration of the rally. Scutineered cars will be identified by a 10x16 sticker given by the Scrutineers.

7. Tyres

7.1 Tyres

Tyres will be of free brand and number.

Only molded, sculpted tires with characteristics compliant with Appendix VI to the N.G. Rally, which is fully adopted for the event, must be used.

The use of studded tyres and anti-deflation systems is forbidden.

7.2 Performance Maintenance Systems

The use of any system for maintaining tire performance at internal pressure equal to or less than atmospheric pressure is expressly prohibited. The internal space of the tire (understood as the space between the rim and the inner part of the tire) must only be filled with air. The use of condensate separators on compressors for tire inflation is authorized solely for the purpose of reducing condensation inside the tire. Inflation with artificially purified gases is prohibited.

7.3 Tyre Heating Systems

The use of artificial tire heating systems, such as tyre warmers or heated containers of any type, is prohibited. Checks will be carried out at the Service Park.

8. Fuel and refueling

8.1 Fuel must comply with ART. 252.9 Appendix "J" 2025.

All competitors must use the fuel supplied in the refueling area (Paddock 2) by the official supplier (single fuel). Competitors will make arrangements directly with the supplier regarding supply and payment.

8.2 Refueling Operations

In the refueling area, crews must wear approved protective clothing. A crew member will open the tank to allow the operator to attach the pump. The crew will be responsible for indicating the required amount of fuel to the supplier. The crew must close the tank once the requested fuel has been dispensed. The Refuelling area is the only area where refueling is authorized.

9. Recce

9.1 Identification of recce cars

The identification number and the "R" sticker (35x25) must be displayed and remain visible during recce.

9.2 Passages

Recce must be carried out with road cars at the times shown in the timetable.

2 (two) passages are allowed on the Shakedown and on each SS.

The control of the passages will be operated by the Marshals.

At the end of the recce, the road cars must be obligatorily taken out of the service park.

9.3 Partial loop Special Stages

Each recce passage of special stages that include a partial loop route is ment to be composed of the external route to the loop and a single lap of the loop route.

10. Sporting Checks and Distribution of Race Material

Sporting checks will be carried out online.

The competitor can delegate a representative to hand any required documents and collect the material.

11. Scruteneering

11.1 Place and time

Thursday 4 December from 16.00 to 19.00 Friday 5 December from 08.00 to 10.00

11.2 General principles

Cars can be brought for technical verification by a Team representative.

At the request of the Technical Commissioners, the competitor must present the car's homologation documents.

In case of non-compliance of the car with technical or safety standards, the Sports Commissioners may set a deadline for compliance, after which the car will not be admitted to the race.

11.3 Sealing and marking

On Rally 2 cars, the Pop off valve and any spare turbo will be sealed.

11.4 Mud flaps

The installation of mud flaps on all wheels in accordance with Appendix J, art. 252.7.7. is not mandatory.

11.5 Side windows

The use of silver or colored films is authorized on the rear side windows, rear window and sunroof, under the following conditions: the films installed on the rear windows must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle with a diameter of 70 mm, so that both the driver and the interior of the car are visible from the outside.

11.6 Driver safety equipment

Driver clothing, including helmets and FHR devices intended for use, must comply with Appendix L chapter III of the FIA.

12. Other procedures

12.1 Shakedown

Participation is optional. Competitors must complete a minimum of 2 Shakedown passes in order and at intervals to be defined by the Race Direction.

During the Shakedown, a full crew on board is not mandatory. The Organizer may allow a passenger on board after signing the liability waiver document.

12.2 Start Order and Intervals

The start orders for the sections will be defined by the Race Direction and displayed on the online race board as per the program.

12.3 Start of the Event

Before the start of SS 1, all cars will be lined up in the Pit Lane (Grid Exhibition) open to the public.

Time and order of entry will be communicated by the Race Direction by Bulletin.

12.4 Re-entry into the Race

In case of withdrawal from the race, a crew may, upon request to the Clek of the Couse, be authorized for re-admission. The Sports Commissioners, in agreement with the Race Direction, will evaluate the requests submitted and the possible re-entry.

Re-entry into the race will be allowed as follows and with the following penalties:

- The Crew must submit a written request to the Race Direction or to the competitor relations officers indicating the section in which they intend to re-enter. The car must be brought into the regrouping area 15 minutes before the theoretical time of the first competitor.
- The crew will be assigned the highest non-anomalous time achieved in their class, plus 2' (2 minutes) for each SS not contested.
- Uncompleted COs will be neutralized without incurring penalties. Once re-entry into the race has been declared, if this does not happen, the crew will be considered definitively withdrawn.

12.5 Car Covers

The use of car covers within night regrouping areas is authorized only according to the following criteria:

- The cover must be transported inside the car, it cannot be brought into the regrouping area from outside.
- The cover can only be placed on the car by the crew itself.
- The car can only be covered after at least 10 minutes have passed since the engine was turned off.
- Solely for the purpose of positioning the cover and until it is positioned, the crew may remain inside the regrouping area, near their car.

12.6 Rally Finish and Final Parc Ferrmè

At the end of the rally, the competing cars will be driven by the crew to the Award Ceremony Stage under Parc Fermé conditions and then taken to the Final Closed Park.

The Race Director, with the authorization of the Sports Commissioners, may release the Closed Park 30 minutes after the publication of the provisional final classification.

12.7 Official Time

For the entire duration of the Rally, the official time will be GPS – UTC+1 (CET).

12.8 Camera Car

Camera cars are allowed; cars must be presented at technical checks with any camera car mounted, so that the Technical Commissioners can check its correct installation.

14. Complaints and Appeals

15. Route description and details

15.1 The race will take place over three days.

Special stage surface: asphalt.

The course is characterized by artificial and natural chicanes, which are part of the race course.

Along the Special Stages, artificial barriers (composed of blocks and cones) will be positioned on straight sections, in curves and to support natural chicanes (description in the road book).

15.2 Special features

15.2.1 GRAND PRIX (33,100 kms)

The "Grand Prix" SS will take place partly on the Old Banking track and partly on the GP track, both modified with artificial chicanes. Crews will have to complete 1 lap of the Old Banking track and 5 laps of the GP track. The number of laps will be recorded on the white line drawn at chicane n.8 (position indicated on the Road Book).

Crews who do not complete the entire "Grand Prix" SS by completing a lower number of laps than expected will be assigned the highest time in their Class plus 2' (2 minutes).

For any additional laps beyond those expected, the total time will be taken into account.

15.2.2 SPECIFIC PENALTIES

Breakdown / Removing the barriers (blocks + cones) composing the chicanes will be sanctioned with a penalty of 10" (10 seconds).

Breakdown / Removing a single cone will be sanctioned with a time penalty of 5" (5 seconds).

A barrier (block and/or cone) will be considered removed when its position needs to be restored.

In case of "chicane jump" (artificial and/or natural), a penalty of 20" (20 seconds) will be applied.

"Chicane jump" means when the car passes completely inside or outside the chicane itself.

The Stewards may decide to inflict further sanctions.

15.2.3 BEHAVIOUR IN CASE OF REMOVAL OF BARRIERS OR CONES

The crews incurring a barrier/cone removed during the running of a Special Stage (partially or totally) must drive the trajectory initially imposed by the barrier; failing to respect the trajectory can be sanioned by the Stewards.

15.2.4 TYRE WARMING AREA

A tyre warmimg area will be set before each Special Stage

"MASTERS SHOW"

The Masters' Show is a Power Stage that will take place on a course of approximately 1,500 km along the central straight of the circuit modified with artificial chicanes. This Special Stage will not be considered for the final classification of the Monza Rally Show.

1) ADMITTED COMPETITORS AND CARS

The competitors and cars admitted to the Masters' Show:

- Rally2: n° XX crews:
 - o crews classified in the first three positions of the official final classification of the Monza Rally Show
 - o crews who have set the XX best times IN SS Autodromo 1 and SS Autodromo 2; if one or more of these crews are among those classified in the first three overall positions of the official final classification of the Monza Rally Show, the crew who has set the 8th best time in SS Autodromo 1 and SS Autodromo 2 will be entitled to participate, then the 9th and so on.
- Rally 3: crews classified in the first two class positions of the official final classification of the Monza Rally Show
- Rally 4: crews classified in the first two class positions of the official final classification of the Monza Rally
- **Historic Cars, for each grouping:** crews classified in the first two grouping positions of the official final classification of the Monza Rally
- Special Goup MRS: crews classified in the first two positions of the Group Classificati

2) ITINERARY

The route/track is located within the main straight of the Monza National Autodrome road circuit, suitably modified with the insertion of chicanes and hairpins created by positioning round bales, tires and plastic barriers; its length is approximately 1,500 km.

Participating cars must go to the pre-start area, located in front of the track entrance gate adjacent to box n. 60, **5 minutes before** the scheduled start time for each car.

For participating cars only, Masters' Show recce is scheduled for Sunday at the end of the Monza Rally Show and must be carried out, in convoy, with the race cars.

3) EXECUTION OF THE STAGE

The timed challenge will take place between two cars; the pairing of competitors will be determined by drawing lots, as soon as the list of participants is made official.

Each crew will perform two stages; the single heat will be carried out over two laps of the track for a total of approximately 3,000 km.

The four best absolute chronological results will be classified for the semifinals where the best time will meet the fourth and the second will meet the third best time.

The semifinals will take place over two stages of 2 laps each.

The crews who have obtained the best sum of times within the individual semifinals will access the final and will compete, in a single stage, in the absolute final which will be contested over three laps of the track for a distance of approximately 4,500 km.

NB: The Organizer may review the number and admission criteria for cars to the stage, following any new content that may appear shortly before the event; any changes will be communicated via information circular.

4) TECHNICAL REPAIRS - WEIGHT

All cars will undergo a weight check before entering the stage and/or after the stage itself; in case of non-compliance, the car will not be admitted to the current stage and/or the subsequent one.

Note: in the period between the end of recce and presentation in the Start Area, as well as between one heat and the next, cars may be brought to the Service Area for any repairs, tire changes, refueling.

5) START

When the two cars are ready on the starting line, the Race Director begins the starting procedure:

Red light on: 10 seconds to startOrange light on: 5 seconds to start

- Green light on: START

The start is given by the green traffic light.

Timing will start from the START signal (green light).

Early starts will be penalized with a penalty of 3" (3 seconds).

For the heats the best result obtained, final classification or time of SS1 and/or 8, will decide the starting side of the two competitors.

best placed driver: side A (starting grid):challenger: side B (Pit Lane)

For the semifinals and the final:

the best time in qualifying or semifinals: side A (starting grid)challenger: side B (Pit Lane)

6) AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony will take place after the race on the podium set up on the track (central straight).

7) CLOSED PARK AT THE END OF THE HEATS

At the end of each heat, all Competitors must immediately bring their car to the Closed Park where they will undergo technical checks before being released.

Competitors who, after participating in a heat, are unable for any reason to bring their car to the Closed Park (due to mechanical failure or other force majeure), must leave the car under the control of the marshals.

No complaints, either sporting or technical, are allowed.
